Guide to Anagraphic and Genealogical Research related to 19th and 20th Centuries

The State Archives of Bergamo keep different valuable sources for anagraphic and genealogical research;

- Registry Office since 1866 to 1900
- Conscription Lists since 1822

These documents are particularly important to get information about the ancestors who emigrated from Bergamo to South America during the 19th Century

Here are some hints for a specific research:

- 1) Before asking for a research, please check the inventories available.
- 2) Verify the existence of the collections and the type of information for the different series.
- 3) See documents in digital copy.

We inform you that the documentation includes the province of Bergamo (the whole territory).
